Poster & Writing School Display
Guelph & District Multicultural Festival

General information: Organized by the Multicultural Festival, the Poster & Writing Display allows students and educators to add the presence of their school to our community showcase. The event is open to ALL Guelph Wellington & Dufferin County students JK-12. New for 2010 Display, is the Digital Art Category that allows students to include computer generated artwork.

Official Rules and Guidelines

Theme: “Peace is...” - Submission Deadline: May 1, 2010

Entries must be the student’s original and previously unpublished work.

Writing Projects must be presented in English, typed and double-spaced, 50 to 200 words for Elementary Divisions, and 100 to 350 for Secondary Divisions.

Posters - All components of the poster must be hand drawn, generated digitally (New!), scanned (New!), and/or derived from original photographs (New!). Teachers are asked to confirm that no copyright infringement has occurred before submitting entries for consideration. Absolutely no Internet images are permitted. Dimensions: standard printer page, size 22 cm X 28 cm or 8.5 inches X 11 inches and should not exceed 50 cm x 50 cm, or 19 inches X 19 inches. ALL work must be submitted in hard copy.

Submissions: To safeguard the privacy of each student, projects should only be signed with the student’s first name or initials on the front. However, in order for the entry to be included in the judging, the student’s full name, grade and school must be clearly printed on the back of each project.

Class Entries will have to be submitted gathered in a binder/book format, with the name of the school and grade/s on the front, and a signed entry form from the teacher, with the list of participating students on the back. In order for the entry to be included in the judging, student’s full name, grade and school must be clearly printed on the back of each project.

Individual Student Entries must include a fully completed entry form (taped on the back) and signed by the parent/Guardian or teacher.

Awards, sponsored by Barzotti Woodworking, are given as an incentive for participation. Judging, by the Guelph Arts Council, is based on the originality, creativity, and overall presentation of the theme. Recipients of the award will be notified prior to the festival.

Liability: The Festival assumes no liability for the loss or damage of the entries submitted.

Agreement: Parents/Guardians/Teachers of participating students agree to the use of entries and/or photos of the event, in any form, by the Guelph & District Multicultural Festival Inc.
